Admissions Qualifications:

SAVY courses are designed for students who typically score in the 95th percentile and above. Courses are fun, challenging, and fast-paced. We ask that you include the most recent copies of cognitive ability or achievement test results to demonstrate that the student can perform at these levels. Accepted tests include, but are not limited to: MAT, CogAT, TCAP, Terra Nova, ERB, Stanford Achievement Test, OLSAT, Woodcock-Johnson, Stanford Binet, and WISC. Returning SAVY students do not need to resubmit test scores.

Students without test scores should work with their school or a local independent testing center for assessment. Although not endorsed or affiliated with Vanderbilt University or Programs for Talented Youth, Learning Matters, a nonprofit agency in the Nashville area, offers eligibility screening for a fee. Visit their Web site, www.learningmattersinc.org, for more information. Be sure to mention SAVY so the appropriate screening instruments will be used.
